New watertight roof solves 17 year leak problem

CalSAVE relationship simplifies, saves on procuring materials

Leaky roofs had plagued the Rod Kelley Elementary School since its 1988 opening; eventually, the Gilroy Unified School District had to replace the roofs. The new roofs included design changes, and had to be installed with a tight maintenance budget and limited internal resources.

Tremco roofing consultant Dan Lajeunesse stepped in to handle the project. Lajeunesse and the team from Tremco managed the roofing system design and budgeting, specification development, pre-construction meetings, job-site and final inspection, and warranty close-out. The project covered 22,000 square feet of roofing over eight buildings. Contractor State Roofing Systems was awarded the contract after a public bid. The CalSAVE contract with the Association of Educational Purchasing Agencies (AEPA) allowed the district to buy the roofing materials directly through CalSAVE at a substantial savings.

After preparing the decking and making necessary repairs, State Roofing Systems installed a cold process BURmastic 100 roofing system. Cold process BURmastic systems are very low odor and have no fire risk, allowing installation to occur with minimal impact on students, faculty and staff.
