To Whom It May Concern:

The US OSHA Hazard Communication Standard and the Canada Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System requires manufacturers or importers to assess and communicate the hazard potential of certain hazardous chemicals or products. This information is typically conveyed by a Safety Data Sheet (SDS).

Products classified as articles are exempt from this provision and are defined as:

US: 1910.1200(c)

"article" means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle:

- (1) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture,
- (2) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use,
- (3) and which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees.

Canada: Hazardous Products Act Section 11

"manufactured article" means any article that is:

- (1) formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture,
- (2) the intended use of which when in that form is dependent in whole or in part on its shape or design,
- (3) and that, under normal conditions of use, will not release or otherwise cause a person to be exposed to a controlled product.

Therefore, based on the above determinations, a Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for the above-mentioned products is not required. If you have any questions, or require any further assistance please contact me.
