Who can use the National Cooperative Contractor Network?

Public educational institutions, public colleges or universities, community colleges, vocational or technical schools, municipal governments, and other governmental and quasi-governmental organizations in New Jersey that are members of MOESC (a public educational agency, established under New Jersey Statute Title 18A) may source and secure in-network contractor services through the MOESC contract held by WTI.

MOESC members can capitalize on a network of highly qualified, local and regional best-in-class, prequalified contractors for their roofing and building envelope projects.



What is the National Cooperative Contractor Network (NCCN)?

The **National Cooperative Contractor Network** program allows public entities (such as K-12, higher education and state/local governments) to leverage the competitively solicited **MOESC** contract for construction, maintenance, repair and restoration projects, ensuring transparency, quality, and cost efficiency. Administered by **Tremco Construction Products Group (CPG)** in partnership with MOESC, this network streamlines the procurement process by prequalifying contractors and eliminating the need for complex bidding requirements. Public entities can confidently award work to trusted local contractors while benefiting from faster project timelines and competitive pricing.

Contractors who apply to be part of the National Cooperative Contractor Network must meet or exceed a variety of predefined criteria representing industry best practices to utilize the MOESC contract. **Criteria include:**

- Industry past performance demonstrating technical capabilities
- A record of proven safety performance
- Prevailing wage documentation
- Acceptance of required contract terms and conditions
- Financial stability and creditworthiness
- Insurance requirements, including liability and workman's compensation
- Never been debarred from public work

✓ What is the pricing structure?

Pricing delivered through the National Cooperative Contractor Network delivery model is fully transparent, consistent and fair. There are no budget surprises because established, competitive, unit-cost prices are based on the RSMeans construction cost database, an industry standard for more than 75 years.
